## Decree no. 10/2023 of 31 March


## Decree exempting citizens of certain countries from presenting an entry visa

Decree no. 10/2023 of 31 March 2023 was published in the Gazette of the Republic no. 63, 1st Series of 31 March 2023, unilaterally exempting citizens of certain countries from presenting entry visas.

National citizens, holders of ordinary passports, of the following countries are exempt from presenting entry visas for tourism and business purposes:

- 1. Canada;
- 2. The Swiss Confederation;
- 3. United Arab Emirates;
- 4. State of Israel;
- 5. United States of America;
- 6. Russian Federation;
- 7. Japan;
- 8. Kingdom of Saudi Arabia;
- 9. Kingdom of Belgium;
- 10. Kingdom of Denmark;
- 11. Kingdom of Spain;
- 12. Kingdom of Norway;
- 13. Kingdom of Sweden;
- 14. Kingdom of the Netherlands;
- 15. United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland;
- 16. Republic of Korea;
- 17. Republic of Côte d'Ivoire;
- 18. Republic of Finland;



- 19. Republic of Indonesia;
- 20. Republic of Ireland;
- 21. Republic of Singapore;
- 22. Republic of Ghana;
- 23. Republic of Senegal;
- 24. Federal Republic of Germany
- 25. French Republic
- 26. Italian Republic;
- 27. People's Republic of China;
- 28. Portuguese Republic; and
- 29. Ukraine.

The exemption of entry visa allows citizens multiple entries in the national territory for a period of stay of 30 days, counting from the first entry, which can be extended for another 30 days, upon justification, and the request must be presented on the website (<a href="www.evisa.gov.mz">www.evisa.gov.mz</a>) or at the Provincial Direction of Migration of the hosting area, at least 48 hours before boarding, upon payment of a processing fee of 650 Meticais.

This exemption does not exempt the citizens covered by the Decree, from complying with the legal formalities regarding entry, stay and exit in force in the Republic of Mozambique, namely:

- a) a passport or similar document, valid for at least six months;
- b) is not prohibited from entering the Republic of Mozambique;
- c) a return flight ticket; and
- d) proof of place of accommodation.
